Course "**Caregiver of people in a situation of dependency**"

1. Introduction

The objective of this report is to present the results of the evaluation of the project entitled: "Collaboration is worth it" as part of key action 2 Erasmus +: Partnerships for cooperation no. project **2022-2-PL01-KA210-VET-000099381**

2. Methodology

The evaluation was carried out based on the survey results. Surveys were sent to each participant who completed the course between October 23, 2023 and November 20, 2023.

3. Project description

The main goal of the project was to create a free online course "**Caregiver of people in a situation of dependency**" on the educational platform. The target group of the project is people who already work in this profession and people who are interested in care for the elderly and disabled. These are also training institutions and lecturers who will be able to use the materials posted on the platform free of charge. The project is also intended to support people with fewer opportunities, i.e. economically and communicationally excluded, immigrants, enabling this group of people to acquire professional qualifications, find a job and improve their life situation.

4. Results of the evaluation of the "**Caregiver of people in a situation of dependency**"

5. Conclusions

76 users took part in the study, 86 surveys were sent to registered people who completed the course by November 20, 2023. The responses received show that each person answered all the questions in the survey.

The "**Caregiver of people in a situation of dependency**" course received positive assessments in terms of:

- Suitability for working with elderly and disabled people (85.4% of users rated it as "very high", 14.6% rated it as "high")
- Quality of teaching materials (82.9% of users rated it as "very high", 14.6% as "high" and 2.4% as average)
- The usefulness of the forum in solving problems in the caregiver's work (70.7% of users rated it as "very high", 24.4% as "high" and 4.9% as "average").
- Recommend the course to other people - as many as 97.6% of people recommend participation in the training to other people, 2.4% answered that they did not know.

The results below show that the course enjoys good opinions, will be willingly recommended to other people, and has not received any negative ratings in all surveyed zones.
